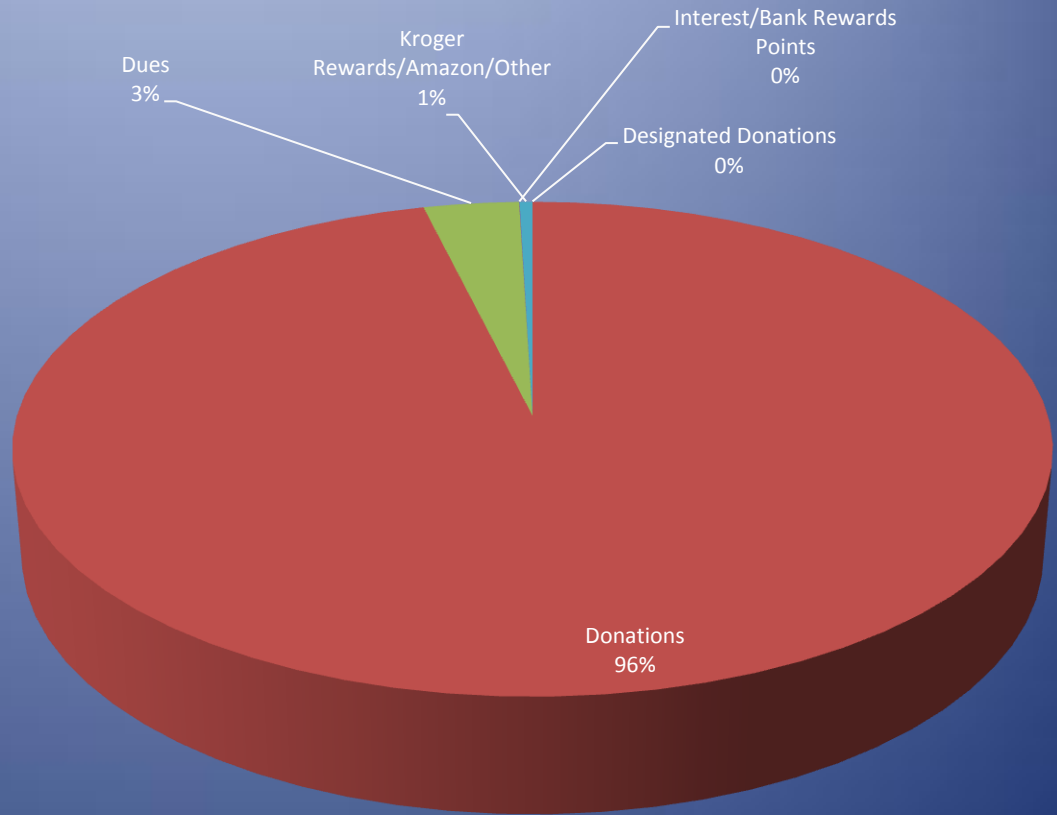

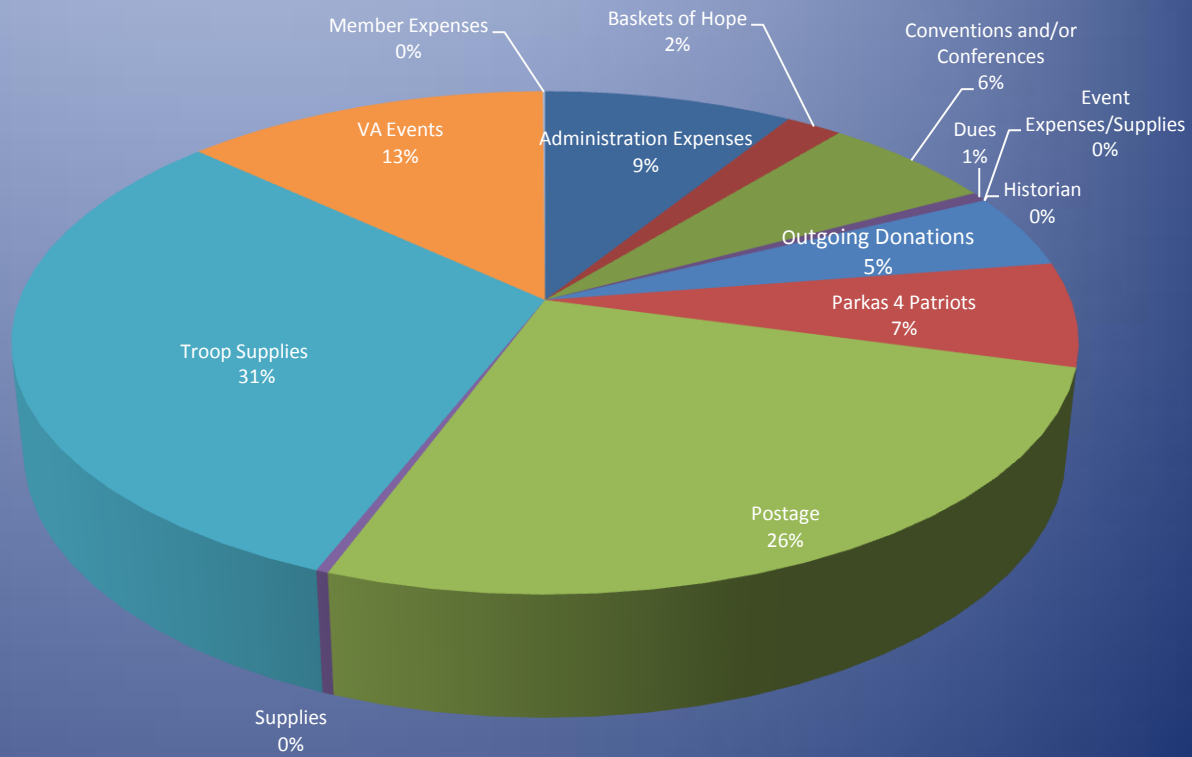

Chart of Accounts

Income Accounts	
Corporate & Foundation Grants	Grants from corporations and foundations - must be tracked separately for tax reporting purposes
Designated Donations	Donations which are designated for a specific purpose or from a major fundraiser. Examples would be Phone Cards and the Charity Golf Outing, Avenue of Flags, Kroger Fundraiser, Dorothy Lany Market Fundraiser
Donations	Donations received which are not designated for a specific purpose. General donations from private citizens or businesses.
Dues	Membership dues for new members and renewing members. Assumed a total of 250 members by year-end with dues of \$20 per year, Big Dipper Dues. Associate members do not pay dues.
Interest/Bank Rewards Points	Interest received on the chapter savings account.
Kroger Rewards/Amazon/Other	Donations received from purchase rewards give back programs like Amazon Smiles and Kroger Community Rewards
Member Income	Member generated income for the purpose of supporting the members: examples are membership pins, BSMA-branded items, sympathy and get well flowers or donations, annual officer installation dinner event, etc.

Chart of Accounts

Expense Accounts	
Administration Expenses:	Administration overhead expenses: Cell phone, Web site hosting fees, Annual fees for post office box and Sam's Club card, Insurance Premiums for troop center.
Dues:	Half of membership dues received from members sent to Department of Ohio of which half goes to National for support of administrative overhead expenses of the organization.
Event Supplies:	Expenses incurred in support of various events: funerals, deployment parties, small fundraisers, etc.
Fundraiser Expenses:	Expenses incurred in support of significant fundraisers such as the Annual Golf Classic.
Outgoing Donations:	Donations to other organizations including annual commitments to Dept. and National levels.
Postage:	Postage for chapter correspondence and troop mailings.
Supplies:	Expenses for various office supplies needed to operate the troop support center such as paper, pens, ink cartridges, tape, boxes, etc.
Troop Supplies:	Purchase of items to pack in care packages for the troops including specially designated items such as phone cards, pillows, thermal underwear, and special requests.
Member Expenses:	Expenses incurred for the purpose of supporting the members: examples are membership pins, BSMA-branded items, sympathy and get well flowers or donations, annual officer installation dinner event, etc.
